



EVAW Help Desk 2010 Rapid Assessment

Statistics

49 requests in 2010, down from 125 in 2009.

96% found the turnaround time to be **quick**. The remaining 4% found it to be fairly quick.

92% of the recipients found the resources and information provided to be **extremely useful**. The remaining 8% found them moderately useful.

Illustrative Uses

Legislation and national action plan resources were used to develop a work plan for the implementation of the gender strategy/policy of the **Indian Ocean** Commission.

Resources on VAW indicators were shared with the UNICEF focal point developing **global** indicators on violence against children.

Statistical resources and data were provided to Measure of America for a VAW resource kit developed in conjunction with the Human Development Report of **North America**.

Resources on VAW and health (in particular on intersections with HIV) were provided to the UNFPA representative, Ministry of Health and Social Welfare, and Ministry of Community Development, Gender and Children in **Tanzania** who is working on strategic investments to provide post-rape care.

Legislation guidance and training manuals for judges were used to prepare workshops for the Regional Women Judges Conference in **Europe**.

Guidance on working with faith-based organizations was provided to develop workshops for religious leaders at the International Ecumenical Peace Convocation in **Jamaica**.

Training materials and guidance on roles and responsibilities of security sector personnel with respect to VAW were used in a presentation with peacekeepers in **Thailand**.

Protocols, training materials and guidelines along with background information on the VAW situation in the country were used to develop a UNDP-supported police training in **Papua New Guinea**.

Illustrative national action plans were shared with UNFPA for the development of a VAW strategy and plan in **Iraq**.
