

# Northwest District Intervention Proposal - Rosario

**PROBLEM**

Women fear and experience sexual harassment and abuse at bus stops and in the streets leading to them

**ACTIVITIES**

- Encouragement, support and training of women to organise and act on women's safety
- Design, planning, and development of a safe corridor for women
- Awareness-raising campaign about violence against women in public spaces
- Activities to strengthen bonds among community organisations and actors

**OUTPUTS:**

- Women trained in matters of gender and safety and have skills to organise
- Presentation and acceptance of the safe corridor planning to the district government.
- Increase in knowledge of general public and government institutions about women's safety in public spaces
- Greater communication and coordination between community organisations to improve sense of community

**OUTCOMES**

- Women see themselves as capable of dialogue with the local government to address the issue together
- Improvements in infrastructure and maintenance of streets and public spaces in the safe corridor.
- Commitment by the decentralised government to sustaining the actions through articulation with organisations and women's groups.
- Local residents and community organizations recognise the safe corridor as a space free from violence against women

**IMPACT**

Decrease in the level of sexual harassment and abuse that women experience in the area of the safe corridor.
